## 3rds, 6ths, 10ths and Octaves in C Major

- 1. Be more interested in the notes you are playing than the fingering.

  Memorize the notes, not only the fingering.
- 2. Be aware of what the notes you are playing look like on the page. All intervals look the same in all keys, although the notes may be different.
- 3. Find a few pieces in C major and look for these intervals. Use music by Fernando Sor, or any easy Baroque or Renaissance pieces.
